*Although Gord Walker kept a record of team and player performances since the "thirties" it was to be 1954 before he was hired to produce formal statistics for the Eastern Conference. His long-time involvement with statistics and expertise in compiling them was an important factor in his being appointed to the position of Director of Information and Media Relations of the Canadian Football League in 1973 at which time he took over the compilation and distribution of statistics out of the League office for both Conferences.*

*The Record Manual in its present form will be a lasting testimony to his expertise in compiling the type of statistical information on which the League relies so heavily for many reasons.*

### ESKIMOS CHRISTEN NEW STADIUM

Not only did Dave Cutler of the Edmonton Eskimos win his fifth Canadian Football League scoring title in seven years in 1978, but he had the distinction of being the first CFL player to put points on the scoreboard in Commonwealth Stadium. The date was August 30, 1978 and the Edmonton Eskimos were playing the first CFL game in the new facility against the B.C. Lions. Cutler who scored 11 points enroute to a 167-point season broke a scoreless tie at 11:04 of the first quarter with a 46-yard field goal. He kicked three field goals, a single and a convert in the game. Fleet-footed Larry Key of the Lions became the first opposing player to score in Commonwealth Stadium when he caught a 38-yard touchdown pass at 12:18 of the second quarter. Key caught three passes for 57 yards and rushed with the ball 16 times for 73 more yards. Lui Passaglia who added the convert accounted for the other B.C. points with a field goal. The remaining Edmonton points were the result of a 50-yard interception return in the second quarter by Joe Hollimon. The game is also important to the history of football in Edmonton for other reasons for it marked the first time the Eskimos played before a home crowd of more than 40,000 (42,527) and it was the sign of great things to come as the Eskies won their first of five consecutive Grey Cup championships later that season.

Only two players in the history of Canadian football have been recipients of the prestigious Lou Marsh Trophy which is presented annually to Canada's Most Outstanding Athlete. Joe (King) Krol of the Toronto Argonauts received the award in 1946 and Russ Jackson of the Ottawa Rough Riders was the 1969 recipient. Krol was considered a triple threat (running, passing and catching) and in the 1946 Grey Cup Game threw three touchdown passes. On one touchdown march, he executed a perfect on-side kick to Royal Copeland. Jackson threw four TD passes in the 1969 Game. Both players were winners of the Jeff Russell Memorial Trophy the same year that they were awarded the Marsh Trophy, and both men are now members of Canada's Sports Hall of Fame and the Canadian Football Hall of Fame.

### August 16, 1958 - 25 Years Ago

Jack Hill led the Saskatchewan Roughriders to a 49-33 victory over the B.C. Lions with 13 points, but the best scoring play and the only one of the season for Bobby Marlow resulted from a 68-yard fumble return. Hill's 13 points on seven converts and a touchdown contributed directly to a Roughrider club record of 145 points in a season, which stood until 1982. Hill was also the leading pass receiver in the Western Football Conference in 1958 as he caught 60 passes for 1,065 yards and 14 touchdowns. Cookie Gilchrist who ultimately finished second to Johnny Bright of the Edmonton Eskimos in the West in yards rushing with 1,254 yards scored two of the five touchdowns he made during the regular playing season in this game, but what is more interesting is that By Bailey of the B.C. Lions scored four touchdowns in 1958 with three of them coming in this game. Saskatchewan completed the regular season in third place with seven wins, seven losses and two ties while the Lions finished in fifth place. The 82 points scored by the Roughriders and the Lions today ranks this game as the eighth highest scoring contest of all time.
